Services

The types of services that CVII provides fall under two main programs; Community Employment and Community Integration. Some individuals may receive services from both programs.

Community Employment

Community Employment provides a variety of services toward preparing, finding, acquiring, learning, and maintaining employment. This program is for individuals that have the desire to work in a competitive work place. Individuals that receive these services may receive assistance with finding work in the community in virtually any type of job. The types of Community Employment services we offer are:
