Resolving the Dilemma between Community Support and Targeted Case Management

Cleveland Vocational offers 2 different programs, Community Employment and Community Integration. HarvestWorks provides services under Community Integration as well.

COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT

If the person only needs assistance with obtaining, learning, and maintaining employment in the community then they may be appropriate for our **Community Employment** program. A person needs a referral from **Vocational Rehabilitation** to come into our “Community Employment” program. It does not matter if the person is or isn’t receiving Community Support or Targeted Case Management.

COMMUNITY INTEGRATION

All of the other services we offer fall under our “**Community Integration**” program. To get into our Community Integration program you must receive a Developmental Disability service (i.e. CAP, Developmental Therapy, ADVP, etc...) that we provide. You will need to have a **Targeted Case Management** company refer you to our Community Integration program. If you need one and do not have one then you may be able to get one through Pathways, 800-898-5898.

If you are receiving **Community Support** services then you will not be able to get into our Community Integration program until you are receiving Targeted Case Management. You must have a Developmental Disability or some other qualifying disability to receive Targeted Case Management. Once you have finished receiving your Community Support services you may start receiving Targeted Case Management if you qualify.
